Video usage is a fun "extra" in cowboy action. We all enjoy seeing our friends shoot. Sometimes we even enjoy watching ourselves, hoping to see great transitions and fantastic accuracy along with hearing the bang, clang and smoke and the questions of "Do I really run that slow?"

With the upcoming annual event and as the practice of videotaping shooters on the firing line is steadily increasing; The Board of the Eldorado Cowboys felt this might be a good time to discuss the SASS policy regarding stage review and scoring and the Eldorado Cowboys policy regarding video activity.

SASS rules:

SASS ROII – printed page 14, "The use of recorded audio, video or still photography cannot be used to make or challenge the call of the Posse or Match Officials".

Eldorado Cowboys Policy on Video:

1. Video recording is currently allowed and encouraged at Eldorado Cowboys events for the personal use/entertainment and/or self-improvement of a shooter.

2. IF a posse leader/ TO/ Match official feels that video activity is interfering with the efficient operation and/or the atmosphere of the posse or match - he/she will have the authority to request any video activity on the firing line cease until such time as deemed appropriate.

3. IF a shooter attempts to utilize video to challenge calls - this behavior may be grounds for a Spirit of the Game penalty.

4. IF video recording will encompass more than a specified shooter (posse videos, group shots, etc.), please ensure you have received verbal permission to record.

SASS matches and Eldorado Cowboys events specifically, are safe, family friendly venues and the Board of the Eldorado Cowboys wants to ensure that events do not become uncomfortable for any shooter.

Shooters are called upon to self-police and utilize video activity only for their personal use/entertainment or self-improvement. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation in this matter.
