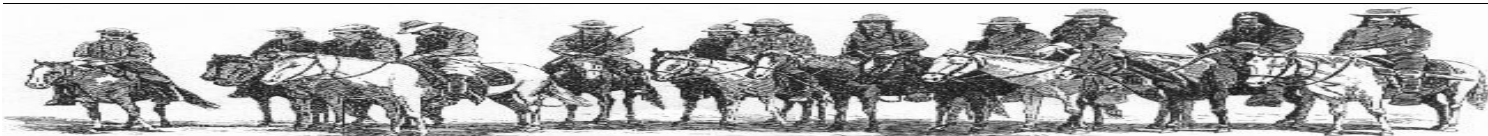

PROCEDURE: You're standing in the door to the brothel, holding a washcloth at the basin. Ya holler, "**Gimmie Back My Money, I fell asleep**". This will start the timer. At the beep, drop the cloth into the pitcher and pick up your shotgun and engage the shotgun targets, **S1, S3, S2**. Set open empty shotgun in the rack provided.

Pick up your rifle & engage rifle targets, double tap **R1, R5, R2, R4**.. Reload 2 rounds and blast them into **R3**. Set your open & empty rifle back in the gun rack.

Go to the left window, pull rope to open window & draw one of your six shooters and engage the pistol targets in the following order: **P1, P5, P2, P4, P3**. Holster empty pistol.

Go to the right window, pull rope to open window & draw your remaining pistol and engage pistols in the following order: **P5, P1, P4, P2, P3**. Holster your empty pistol.

SCORING: Raw time plus 5-second penalty for each target missed, procedural is additional 10-second penalty.
